### OBSERVATIONS Re. THE ISSUE OF ABORTION

Commenting on Psalms 139:7-16, especially on the term “made” (verse 15, NKJV, et al) as defined by *Biblesoft’s New Exhaustive Strong’s Numbers and Concordance with Expanded Greek-Hebrew Dictionary*, Calvin Fields wrote, as follows...

The word “created” comes from a “primitive root; to erect, i.e., create... by implication to own.” Abortion is an act of destruction against what God, as the Creator of natural law “knit together.” The context clearly shows that from the ‘unformed body,” in its most elemental, constituent parts, to an adult person, God **sees**, through His omniscient power, the formation and development of life. By any reasonable criteria, **conception brings and joins together all necessary genetic elements of life!** Attachment of the fertilized egg to the uterine wall then turns the mother into a “life support system.” Abortion, which “disconnects” the life, is no different and no less wrong than “pulling the plug” on a comatose person who has every chance of full recovery. An act every court in America would consider premeditated murder.

How, then, can pregnant women, and support groups who approve and even encourage their abortive actions, justify their actions? Who gave them the right to consider that which God “created” and “owns” a disposable “fetus,” a thing of “choice”? No president, no governor, no legislature, no court “under God” has the authority to “approve” of this heinous defiance of His laws.
