The Lechaion Road originated in Lechaion, the port city of ancient Corinth. Paved with marble, sometimes more than 20 feet wide, it ended at the monumental entrance to Corinth.



"It is actually reported that

there is sexual immorality among you, and sexual immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the

Gentiles,

Segue into Chapter 6 - 1 Corinthians 5:9-13 I wrote you in my letter not to associate with sexual sinners; I did not at all mean with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous and swindlers, or with idolaters, for then you would have to go out of the world. But actually, I wrote to you not to associate with any socalled brother if he is promiscuous, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler-not even to eat with such a one. For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within the church? But those who are outside, God judges. Remove the wicked man from among yourselves.



Yes, 6:1-8 are about lawsuits, But <u>context</u> is judging sinner of Ch. 5

AND...

Segue into Chapter 7 - 1 Cor. 6:9, 13, 15, 18

Neither fornicators (sexual sinners), nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals... will inherit the kingdom of God.

The body is not for sexual sin, but for the Lord, and the Lord is for the body.

Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? May it never be! Or do you not know that the one who joins himself to a prostitute is one body with her? For He says, "The two shall become one flesh."

... Flee sexual sin. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the sexual sinner sins against his own body.

Seque into Chapter 7 - 1 Corinthians 6:9f

Neither fornicators (sexual sinners), idolaters, adulterers, effeminate, homosexuals, nor thieves, covetous, drunkards, revilers, swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.

List contains 10 items Five are inherently (or usually: idolatry) sexual

1 CORINTHIANS 5, 6, and 7 All three chapters deal with sexual sin
