


Forbidding Marriage (1 Timothy 4:1-3) Commanding Divorce (Malachi 2:16)

18 The Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone.

"alone" does NOT equal "unmarried"

then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place. 22 The Lord God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man.

Apparently "incest" (brothers with sisters) was perfectly legal before Moses Law (not after)



20 Adah gave birth to Jabal. He was the father of those who dwell in tents and have livestock.

21 His brother's name was Jubal. He was the father of all those who play the lyre and pipe.

22 Zillah also gave birth to Tubal-cain, the forger of all implements of bronze and iron.

19 Lamech took to himself two wives. The name of the one was Adah, and the name of the other, Zillah.

Tents, Livestock, Lyres, Pipes, Bronze, Iron, and Polygamy all perfectly legal before Moses
