WHEN MANKIND REBELS, WHAT DOES GOD DO?

Adam & Eve:	Cast out of the Garden to suffer	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Cain kills Abel:	Wanderer, no man could kill	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Noah's World:	All but eight drowned	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Ham sees Noah:	Cursed, servant to brothers	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Babel:	Language confused, scattered	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Pharoah & Sarai:	Great plagues	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Sodom & G:	Fire and brimstone destruction	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Lot's wife:	Pillar of salt	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Pharoah:	HARD HEART = 10 plagues	NO ALLOWANCE MADE
Pharoah:	HARD HEART = Drowned	NO ALLOWANCE MADE

**WHAT VERSES IN O. T. SAY ANY MORAL
OR MARRIAGE LAW EVER CHANGED?**

I believed God CHANGED Marriage Law.

I also believed God LOWERED Marriage Law.

I believed God allowed easy divorce to Jews alone.

CONSEQUENCES:

1. God allowed covenant breaking.

2. God made the wives pay the price.

3. God made the children pay the price.

4. God was partial (and favored) the evil men.

5. Let us do evil that evil may be ALLOWED.

Now that I've actually LOOKED...

I find no place where God yields to man's sin or rebellion.

I find no place where God ever SAYS He is yielding to sin.

Besides, Moses' Law didn't LOWER any standards.

I rather think, now, that Moses RAISED standards.

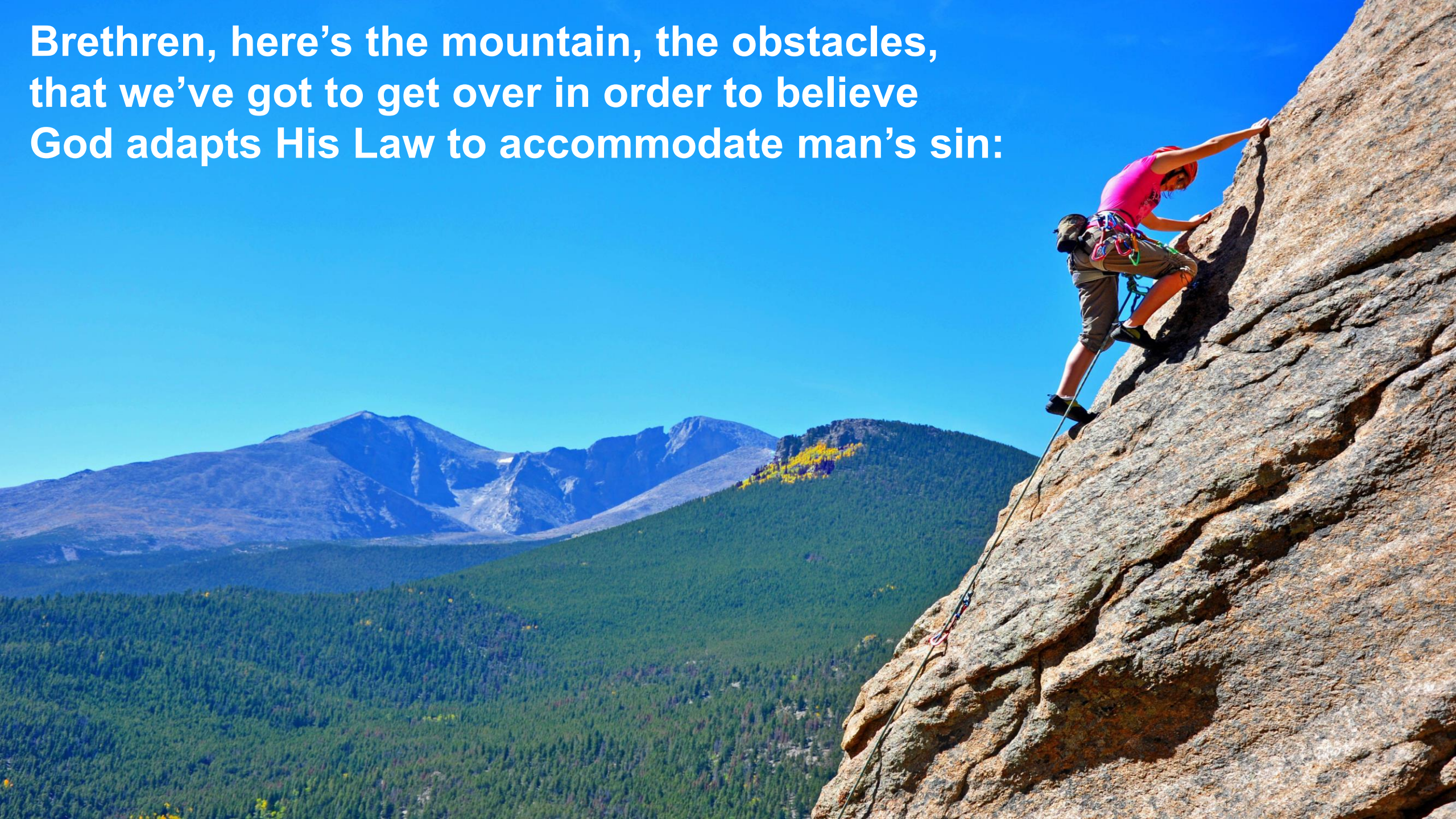

**Brethren, here's the mountain, the obstacles,
that we've got to get over in order to believe
God adapts His Law to accommodate man's sin:**



**If, in all the Old Testament,
God Lowered Moral or Marriage Law:**

- 1. He never SAID He did. (No Command)**
- 2. He never gave an example. (No Example)**
- 3. He never implied that He did. (No Inference)**
- 4. He'd have yielded to sin.**
- 5. He'd have been partial to sinners.**
- 6. He'd have permitted covenant breaking.**
- 7. He'd have abandoned the wives & children.**
- 8. He'd have allowed evil that evil might come.**

Four Bedrock Principles:

1. Better to marry than burn
2. Stay in current condition
3. Don't forbid marriage
4. Don't promote divorce
