John 16:13F When He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you.

John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

Genesis 1:1-3 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was moving over the surface of the waters. 3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

"The Word of God" Appears in 44 verses

"The Word"

Balaam: The word God puts in my mouth, that I shall speak.
Moses: This is the word which the Lord has commanded.
David: The word of Your lips
Psalm: The word which He commanded
Psalm: The word to Your servant
Daniel: The word concerning Nebuchadnezzar

At this point we're over 100 uses of "The Word" in one form or another
