ROMANS 6:23

*The wages of sin is **death**,
but the free gift of God
is eternal **life**
in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Now, look at the CONTRAST

2 CORINTHIANS 2:15F

15 We are a fragrance of Christ to God
among those who are being **saved**
and among those who are **perishing**.

16 To the one an aroma from **death to death**,
to the other an aroma from **life to life**.

Now, look at the CONTRAST

MATTHEW 7:13f

*13 Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to **destruction**, and there are many who enter through it. 14 For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to **life**, and there are few who find it.*

Now, look at the CONTRAST

MATTHEW 10:28

*Do not fear those who **kill the body**
but are **unable to kill the soul (life)**;
but rather fear Him who is able
to **destroy both soul (life) and body**
in hell (Gehenna).*

Romans 9:22

What if God, although willing to demonstrate His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much patience vessels of wrath prepared for destruction?



Seven **MORE** passages on DESTRUCTION

1 Corinthians 3:16f

You are a temple of God. . . 17 If any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, and that is what you are.



Seven MORE passages on DESTRUCTION

Philippians 1:27

Conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel. . . 28 in no way alarmed by your opponents—which is a sign of destruction for them, but of salvation for you, and that too, from God.



Seven **MORE** passages on DESTRUCTION

Philippians 3:18f

They are enemies of the cross of Christ,
19 whose end is destruction



Seven MORE passages on DESTRUCTION

2 Thessalonians 1:9

These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction,
away from the presence of the Lord.



Seven MORE passages on DESTRUCTION

Hebrews 10:39

We are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul. (life)



Seven MORE passages on DESTRUCTION

James 4:12

There is only one Lawgiver and Judge,
the One who is able to save and to destroy.



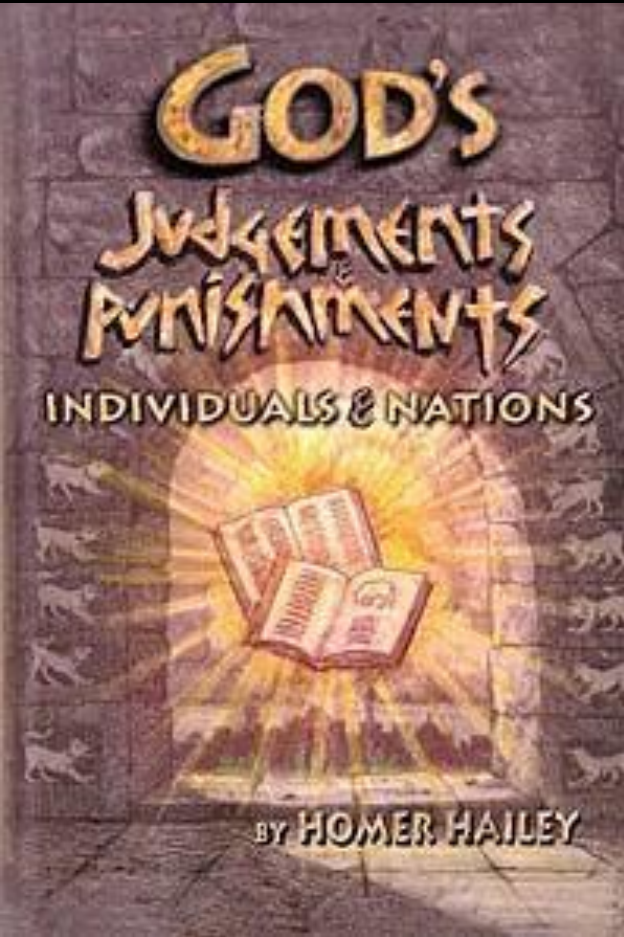
