- Used of Jesus as appointed by God to office, Lk. 23:35
- Used of angels as those whom God had chosen of all created beings to be particularly associated with Him, I Tim. 5:21

God's special person, I Pe. 2:9

- Used in secular writing of the son of the Roman emperor by Josephus
- Used of kings, Mt. 10:18
- Of christians who reign with Christ, Rev. 1:6

God's special person, I Pe. 2:9

... ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an **holy** nation, a peculiar people

- Used of things which on account of association with God possess a certain distinction, Acts 7:25
- Used of persons whose services God employs, Eph. 3:5 (apostles); I Th. 3:13 (men)
- Used of things set apart for God to be exclusively His, Lk 2:23

God's special person, I Pe. 2:9

- Used of one's own property, Eph. 1:14
- Used of a thing preserved, usually the soul that is may partake of eternal salvation, Heb. 10:39

- To be succored as one afflicted or seeking aid, Mt. 9:27
- Of God granting to the unworthy favor, benefits, and opportunities, Rom 9:15 who then accord the same to others
