Qualifications of a Prophet

1. Role of a prophet

Deuteronomy 18: 18 - 20

¹⁸ 'I will raise up a **prophet** from among their countrymen like you, and <u>I will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.</u>

- ¹⁹ 'It shall come about that whoever will not listen to My words which he shall speak in My name, I Myself will require *it* of him.
- ²⁰ 'But the prophet who speaks a word presumptuously in My name which I have not commanded him to speak, or which he speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.' ³

Qualifications of a Prophet

2. God speaks to us through the prophets

Hosea 12: 10

¹⁰ I have also spoken to the prophets, And I gave numerous visions, And through the prophets I gave parables.

3. God reveals His plans to the prophets Amos 3: 7

⁷ Surely the Lord GOD does nothing Unless He reveals His secret counsel To His servants the prophets.

- ¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- ² He was in the beginning with God.

³⁹ And He went a little beyond *them,* and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."

Jesus as a Prophet

Matthew 13: 57

⁵⁷ And they took offense at Him. But <u>Jesus said</u> to

them, <u>"A prophet is not without honor except in his</u> hometown and in his own household."

¹¹ And the crowds were saying, <u>"This is the prophet</u> Jesus, from Nazareth in Galilee."

Luke 24: 19

¹⁹ And He said to them, "What things?" And they said to Him, "The things about <u>Jesus the Nazarene</u>, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word in the sight of God and all the people, 7

- 1. Able to offer gifts and sacrifices for sin
- 2. Compassionate
- 3. Called by God

Jesus as a High Priest

Hebrews 3: 1

¹ Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider **Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest** of our confession;

Hebrews 4: 14

¹⁴ Therefore, since we have a **great high priest** who has passed through the heavens, **Jesus the Son of God**, let us hold fast our confession.

Hebrews 6: 19 - 20

¹⁹ This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a *hope* both sure and steadfast and <u>one which enters within the vei</u>l, ²⁰ where <u>Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us</u>, having become a <u>high priest forever</u> according to the order of Melchizedek.

1. Like Melchizedek

Hebrews 5: 10

¹⁰ being designated by God as a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 7: 1 – 3

¹ For this <u>Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most</u> <u>High God</u>, who met Abraham as he was returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him,

² to whom also Abraham apportioned a tenth part of all the spoils, was first of all, by the translation of his name, <u>king of righteousness</u>, and then also king of Salem, which is <u>king of peace.</u>

of peace. ³ Without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, he remains a **priest perpetually**.

2. Immortal

Hebrews 7: 23 - 24

 ²³ The *former* priests, on the one hand, existed in greater numbers because they were prevented by death from continuing,
 ²⁴ <u>but Jesus, on the other hand, because</u> <u>He continues forever, holds His</u> <u>priesthood permanently.</u>

3. <u>Complete</u>

Hebrews 7: 25 Therefore <u>He is able also to</u> <u>save forever those who draw near to God</u> <u>through Him, since He always lives to make</u> <u>intercession for them.</u>

4. <u>Sinless</u>

Hebrews 7: 26 For it was fitting for us to have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens; 12

5. Unique

Hebrews 7: 27 – 28

²⁷ who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the *sins* of the people, because this <u>He did once for all when He offered up</u> <u>Himself</u>.

²⁸ For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.

6. <u>Heavenly</u>

Hebrews 9: 23 - 24

²³ Therefore it was necessary for the copies of the things in the heavens to be cleansed with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.

²⁴ For Christ did not enter a holy place made with hands, a *mere* copy of the true one, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us;14

Qualifications of God's King

1. <u>Son of God</u>

Psalm 2: 6 – 7

⁶ "But as for Me, I have installed My King Upon Zion, My holy mountain."

⁷ "I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.

2. Son of David

Psalm 132: 11

¹¹ The LORD has sworn to David A truth from which He will not turn back: "Of the fruit of your body I will set upon your throne.

Qualifications of God's King

3. <u>Righteous</u>

Psalm 45: 6 - 7

⁶ Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom.

7 You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness;

Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of joy above Your fellows.

4. Victorious over Death

Psalm 16: 10 For You will not abandon my soul to Sheol; Nor will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.

Qualifications of God's King

5. Ascended to Heaven

Psalm 110: 1 – 2

¹ The LORD says to my Lord: <u>"Sit at</u> <u>My right hand Until I make Your</u> <u>enemies a footstool for Your feet."</u>
² The LORD will stretch forth Your strong scepter from Zion, *saying*, "Rule in the midst of Your enemies."

Jesus as God's King

Matthew 27: 11

¹¹ Now <u>Jesus stood before the governor</u>, and the governor questioned Him, saying, "<u>Are You the King of the</u> <u>Jews</u>?" And <u>Jesus said to him, "It is as you say."</u>

Matthew 27: 37

³⁷ And **above His head** they put up the charge against Him which read, **"THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS."**

Acts 17: 6 - 7

⁶ When they did not find them, they began dragging Jason and some brethren before the city authorities, shouting, "These men who have upset the world have come here also; 7 and Jason has welcomed them, and they all act contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, Jesus."

Jesus is qualified to be God's King

1. <u>Son of God</u>

Luke 1: 31 - 35

³¹ <u>"And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus.</u>

³² "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David;

³³ and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end."

³⁴ Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?"

³⁵ The angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the <u>holy Child shall be called the Son of God</u>.

⁴ who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord,

Hebrews 1: 8 - 9

⁸ But of the Son *He says,* "YOUR THRONE, O GOD, IS FOREVER AND EVER, AND THE RIGHTEOUS SCEPTER IS THE SCEPTER OF HIS KINGDOM.

⁹ "YOU HAVE LOVED RIGHTEOUSNESS AND HATED LAWLESSNESS; THEREFORE GOD, YOUR GOD, HAS ANOINTED YOU WITH THE OIL OF GLADNESS ABOVE YOUR COMPANIONS."

Acts 2: 22 – 24

²² "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know—
 ²³ this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and

²³ this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put *Him* to death.

²⁴ "But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

Acts 2: 32

³² <u>"This Jesus God raised up again, to which we are all witnesses.</u>

Jesus is qualified to be God's King 4. <u>Victorious over Death</u>

Acts 13: 32 - 33

³² "And we preach to you the good news of the promise made to the fathers,

³³ that <u>God has fulfilled this</u> <u>promise to our children in that He</u> <u>raised up Jesus</u>, as it is also written in the second Psalm, 'YOU ARE MY SON; TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU.'

5. <u>Ascended to Heaven</u>

Acts 2: 33 – 36

³³ <u>"Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of</u> <u>God, and having received from the Father the promise of</u> <u>the Holy Spirit, He has poured forth this which you both</u> <u>see and hear.</u>

³⁴ "For it was not David who ascended into heaven, but he himself says: 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND,

³⁵ UNTIL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES A FOOTSTOOL FOR YOUR FEET."

³⁶ "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ—this Jesus whom you crucified."
