CHRONOLOGY OF JEREMIAH

- The chronology of Jeremiah is at most times confusing and requires one to pay careful attention to context and rely heavily on the associated history given in The Book of Kings and the Chronicle of the Kings.
- This chart helps to arrange most of Jeremiah chronologically.

JEREMIAH ACCUSED OF FALSE TEACHING

- What did Johanan say about Jeremiah's prophecy?
 - He accused Jeremiah of telling a lie and being led by Baruch to bring the people back to Judah just to be killed or enslaved and exiled by the Babylonians.

THE REMNANT GO TO EGYPT AGAINST GOD'S WILL

- Who went to Egypt?
 - Johanan and all the commanders of the forces took the remnant of Judah
 - The men, the women, the children, the king's daughters, and every person Nebuzaradanhad left with Gedaliah
 - Jeremiah and Baruch

NEBUCHADNEZZAR WILL SET UP HIS THRONE IN EGYPT

- Where would the Lord kindle fire in Egypt?
 - The temples of the gods of Egypt
 - He will burn them and take them captive
 - He will wrap himself in Egypt as a shepherd wraps himself in his coat



JUDAH'S SIN IN EGYPT IDENTIFIED

- In what were they provoking the Lord to wrath?
 - The works of their hands
 - Burning sacrifices to other gods in Egypt
 - Going to Egypt in the first place
 - They will become a curse and a reproach among the nations

THE FACE OF THE LORD IS AGAINST THOSE IN EGYPT

- Why did the Lord say none would return from Egypt?
 - They had ignored the word of the Lord and kindled His wrath by fleeing to and residing in Egypt
 - He would send the sword and famine and pestilence after them.
 - None would return except for a few refugees

THE PEOPLE VOW TO BURN INCENSE TO THE QUEEN OF HEAVEN

- Why did the women say they would burn incense to the queen of heaven?
 - Because when they were sacrificing to the queen of heaven they had plenty
 - When they stopped sacrificing to the queen of heaven they lacked everything and met their end



THEIR INCENSE WAS AN ABOMINATION TO THE LORD WHEN THEY WERE IN JUDEA

- Why happened to Judah because of the sacrifices they made to false gods?
 - Their land had become a ruin, an object of horror, and a curse, without an inhabitant

THE LORD WILL WATCH OVER THEM FOR EVIL AND NOT GOOD

- What sign dd the Lord give to the Israelites in Egypt that He would punish them?
 - Pharaoh Hophra king of Egypt will be given to the hand of his enemies, just as Zedekiah king of Judah was given to Nebuchadnezzar

 - In the land of the north by the river Euphrates

THE LORD WILL BRING PUNISHMENT AGAINST EGYPT

- Why were the valiant men of Egypt swept away?
 - The Lord had thrust hem down
 - They have fallen over one another and run home to get away from the sword of the oppressor.
- In Egypt, upon whom did the Lord say He would bring punishment?
 - Amon of Thebes, Pharaoh, and Egypt along iwht her gods and her kings

BUT ISRAEL WILL BE SAVED FROM AFAR

- What would the Lord make a complete end of?
 - The nations were He had driven Jacob

LESSONS AND APPLICATIONS

- 43:9-13 Jeremiah is commanded to hide large stones in the sight of the men of Judah. When we are in the midst of enemies and in foreign lands, we must still proclaim the word of the Lord.
- 44:17-19 The women vow to continue offering sacrifices to a false god, the queen of heaven. The reason they give is their prosperity. Sometimes people attribute their prosperity to the forces of this world and as a result they worship the world. Anyone can leave Jehovah God out of the picture of their lives if they really want to.

LESSONS AND APPLICATIONS

 In the punishment of Egypt, and the nations to follow, we are again reminded of the fact that God is ruler of ALL nations. He will call all nations into account as long as this world stands.
