- 2 through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.

#### **Ephesians 3:6-7**

- 6 to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel,
- 7 of which I was made a minister, according to the gift of God's grace which was given to me according to the working of His power.

- 5 He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will,
- 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

## B. Adoption into the family of God

#### Galatians 4:4-7

- 4 But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law,
- 5 so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.
- 6 Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"
- 7 Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.

- seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God.

#### C. An inheritance from God

#### Our inheritance in Christ is imperishable and undefiled.

- 1 Peter 1:3-5
- 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- 4 to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,
- 5 who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

C. An inheritance from God

#### Our inheritance in Christ is reserved.

#### **Ephesians 1:13-14**

13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, <u>the</u> <u>gospel of your salvation</u>—<u>having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise</u>,

14 who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of *God's own* possession, to the praise of His glory.
