



View from Mount Arbel down to the Sea of Galilee's North Shore





At least 20 Proverbs deal with Anger

- 16:32 He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty 14:29 He who is slow to anger has great understanding,
- 22:24f Do not associate with a man given to anger; or go with a hot-tempered man,
 Or you will learn his ways and find a snare for yourself.

but he who is quick-tempered exalts folly.

- 19:19 A man of great anger will bear the penalty, For if you rescue him, you will only have to do it again.
 - 29:22 An angry man stirs up strife, and a hot-tempered man abounds in transgression.

EPHESIANS 4:26f Be angry and yet do not sin.

Do not let the sun go down on your anger, and do not give the devil an opportunity.

EPHESIANS 4:29-32

- 29 Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear.
- 30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- 31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.
- 32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.
