The value of the WORD:

1. It is Food

Job 23:12

¹² "I have not departed from the command of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food.

Matthew 4:4

⁴ But He answered and said, "It is written, 'MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.'"

a. Milk for the baby

1 Peter 2:2

² like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation,

b. Meat for the growing

Hebrews 5:12-14

- For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food.
- ¹³ For everyone who partakes *only* of milk is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for he is an infant.
- ¹⁴ But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil.

c. Bread for everyone

John 6:51

⁵¹ "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh."

Psalm 19:10

¹⁰ They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb.

John 17:17

17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

4. It is a Mirror

James 1:23-25

²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴ for *once* he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. ²⁵ But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the *law* of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man will be blessed in what he does.

Ephesians 5:25-27

²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, ²⁶ so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, ²⁷ that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

Psalm 119:149-150

- Hear my voice according to Your lovingkindness; Revive me, O LORD, according to Your ordinances.

 Those who follow after wickedness.
- ¹⁵⁰ Those who follow after wickedness draw near; They are far from Your law.

6. It is a Seed

1 Peter 1:23

²³ for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, *that is,* through the living and enduring word of God.

7. It is a Sword

Ephesians 6:17

¹⁷ And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Hebrews 4:12

¹² For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

²⁹ "Is not My word like fire?" declares the LORD, "and like a hammer which shatters a rock?
