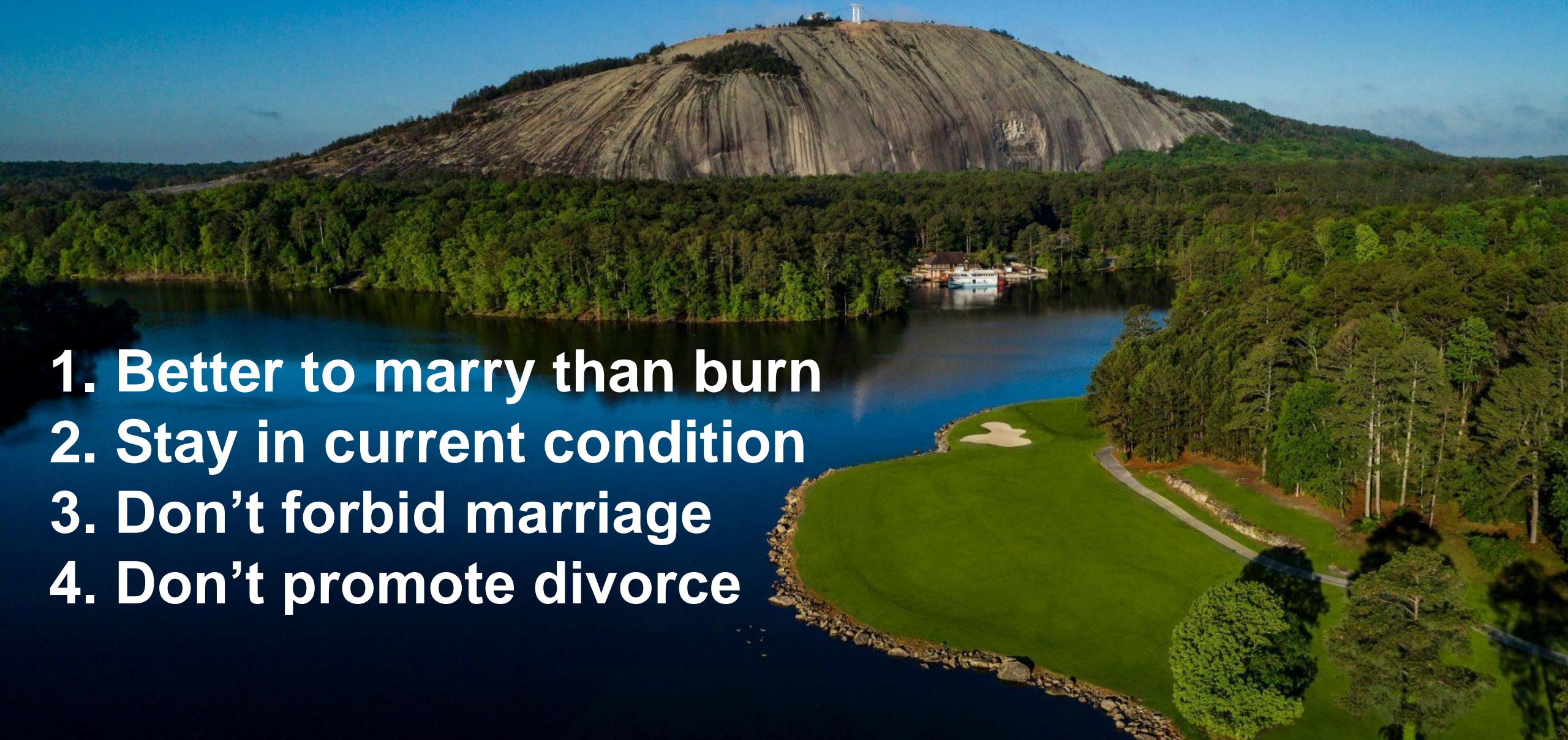

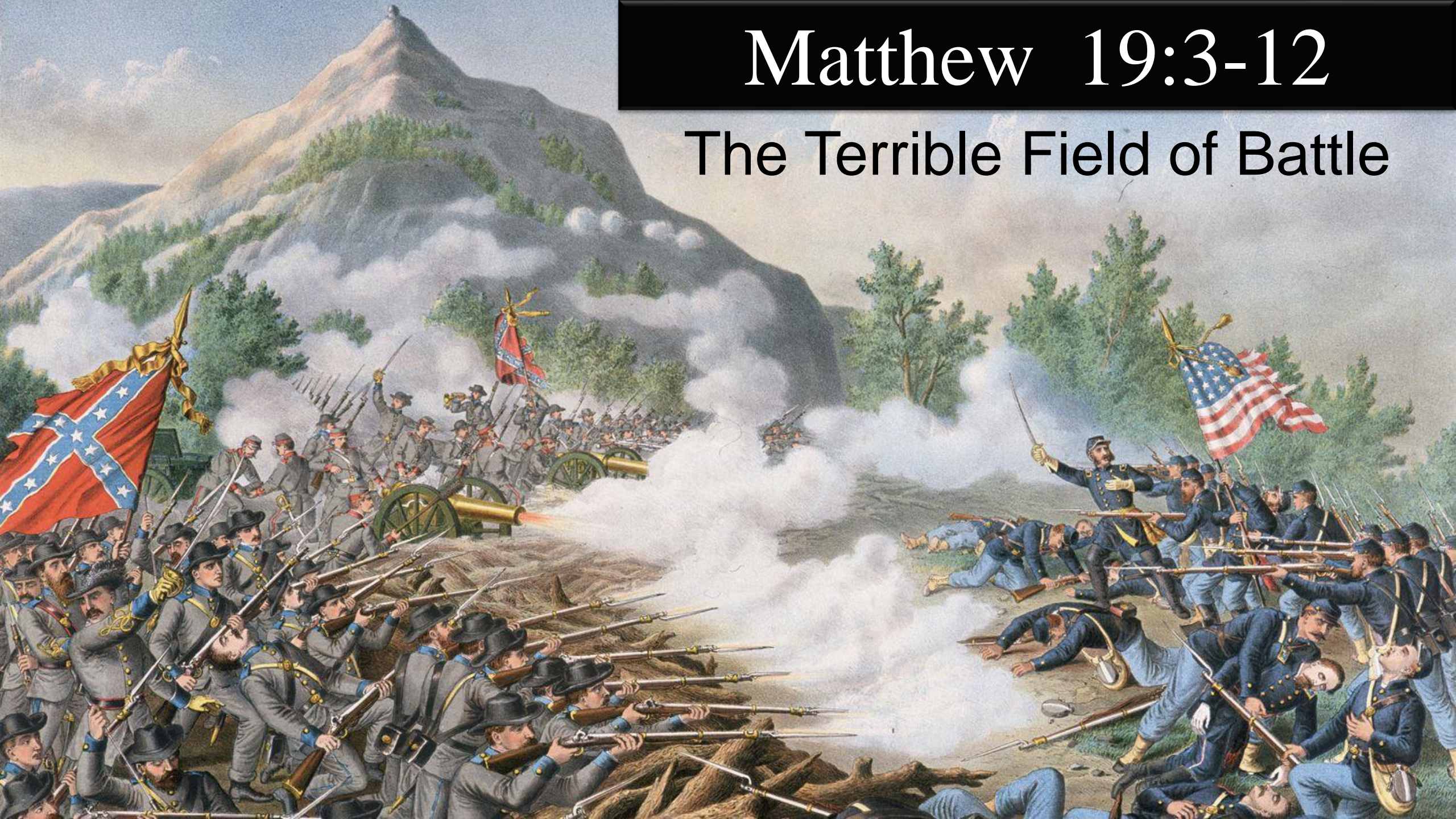
# Four Bedrock Principles:

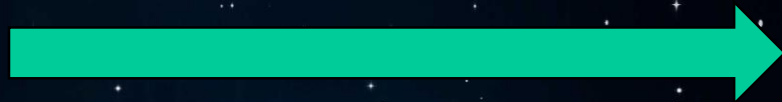
