"HELL" is English Word

Hebrew word = Sheol

Greek word = Hades

Greek word = Gehenna

Greek word = Tartarus

SHEOL is Hebrew Word

Appears 31 times in the Old Testament KTV translates "grave, pit, or hell"

Literally = "Unseen"

HADES is Greek Word

Appears 10 times in the New Testament KIV translates "hell" every time NAS transliterates "Hades" every time Literally = Unseen

Not used in Old Testament at all, BUT... Joshua 15:8 & 18:16 = Valley of Hinnom 2 Kings 23:10 = "Topheth in the valley of the son of Hinnom" 2 Chron. 28:3 = "Valley of Ben-Hinnom"

Ver. 7:31-34 = "Valley of the son of Hinnom"

Jesus built church despite Hades. Lazarus was there (among the dead) Tesus was there for 3 days Death & Hades have dead in them Death & Hades thrown in Lake of Fire
