

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ZEDEKIAH INQUIRES OF THE LORD CONCERNING NEBUCHUDNEZZAR

What was Zedekiah's hope when he inquired of the Lord
That the Babylonian King Nebuchudnezzar would withdraw from warring against Judah, out of kindness and wonder of the Lord.

- What ways did the Lord set before them?
 - The way of life and death
- When these things happen, who is the one who will live?
 - Those who leave Jerusalem and surrender to the Chaldeans.

I will make your weapons of war fail and the babylonians will take your city

• In anger and wrath the Lord will war against Judah. With pestilence the Lord will kill the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Then those who survive pestilence, sword and famine will become slaves the the babylonians

• The Lord is against them all, wherever they live, whoever they are.

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
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IF THE KING DOES RIGHT, KINGS WOULD ENTER JERUSALEM AGAIN
