


Jesus Mission and Poverty Mark 14:1-7





Jesus Begins His Ministry

- Isaiah said He would preach the good news, Luke 4:18-19
  - To those at the bottom of the social pyramid
    - Poor people,
    - Women,
    - Samaritans,
    - Lepers,
    - Prostitutes,
    - Tax collectors
  - To those at the *pinnacle*
  - He preached the same message to all

## God's Abiding Instructions

- Do not take advantage of the poor man, Exodus 23:6
- Do not give advantage to the poor man
  - Proverbs 24:23
  - Judge the rich and poor equally (do not favor the poor) Exodus 23:3; Leviticus 19:15; Deuteronomy 1:17, 16:19
- Become like God, Deuteronomy 15:7-11
- Hold men accountable, II Thessalonians 3:10

## Things that Can't Coexist, James 2:1-7



- Respect of persons
  - Literally "lift up the face" (ISBE)
  - Frequently used of a supplicant "receive him with favor"
  - Came to mean "to accept the person instead of the cause" or "show partiality"
- The faith of Jesus
  - Samaritan woman John 4
  - Cornelius (Greek) accepted
  - Claims of favored status by Jews, Romans 2:1-11
