- ³ "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, *there* you may be also.

John 14:6

⁶ Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

I am the Way - That leads so the Father

Greek -way

hodos noun

Road, way, highway.

Christ is the Way:

1. By His doctrine

John 6:68-69

68 Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life.

⁶⁹ "We have believed and have come to know that **You are the Holy One of God**."

2. By His example

1 Peter 2:21-22

For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps,

22 WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH;

3. By His sacrifice

Hebrews 9:11-12

¹¹ But when **Christ** appeared as a **high priest** of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation;
¹² and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

4. By His Spirit

John 16:13

¹³ "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

Greek -TRUTH

alētheia noun

Truth; dependability, freedom from error, integrity

- 1. He is the Truth:
- A. In opposition to all false religions.
- B. To the Mosaic law, which was only the shadow, not the truth or substance, of the good things which were to come.

C. In respect to all the promises of God

2 Corinthians 1:20-22

For as many as are the <u>promises of God</u>, <u>in</u> <u>Him they are yes</u>; therefore also <u>through Him</u> <u>is our Amen to the glory of God through us</u>.

Now He who establishes us with you in

Christ and anointed us is God,
who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit

in our hearts as a pledge.

2. Jesus Christ is the Communicator of truth

The <u>life</u>, the <u>purity</u>, and the <u>teaching of Jesus</u>
<u>Christ</u> was complete and was a perfect
representation of the things of the eternal world
communicated to man for his salvation.

John 1:17

¹⁷ For the Law was given through Moses; **grace** and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.

3. Jesus Christ is the *Liberator* of truth

John 8:31-32

So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, *then* you are truly disciples of Mine;

and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

John 15:3

³ "You are already <u>clean because of the word</u> which <u>I</u> have spoken to you.

Greek - Life

zōē noun

Life.

1. Jesus Christ lived perfectly - He possesses life perfectly.

He is the Life: the very embodiment, energy, force, and source of life itself.

John 1:4

⁴ In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.

John 11:24-26

²⁴ Martha *said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day."

²⁵ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do

you believe this?"

but put to death the Prince of life, the one whom God raised from the dead, a fact to which we are witnesses.
