A. God gave us our inheritance in Christ Ephesians 1: 3 - 14

- 1. His Will: His will is for us to receive all that He has for us.
- 2. His Grace: It's His unmerited, undeserved favor.
- 3. His Glory: It's His desire to glorify Himself by giving us spiritual wealth.
- 4. His Power: It's His power that creates all, preserves all, and provides all.
- 5. His Love: He loves us.

A. God gave us our inheritance in Christ

Ephesians 1: 3 - 14

- **6. His Pleasure:** It gives Him great joy to give to His children.
- 7. His Purpose: Before the foundation of the world, He planned our inheritance.
- 8. His Calling: He calls us into salvation, sanctification, and service.
- 9. His Inheritance: Our name is on His will for eternity.
- 10. His Workmanship: We are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works.

B. How do we receive our inheritance in Christ?

When we obey the gospel, we are included in the inheritance of the saints.

- 1. In Him we have adoption
- 2. In Him we have redemption
- 3. In Him we have an inheritance

B. How do we receive our inheritance in Christ?

Believers in Jesus Christ are referred to as God's children.

John 1:12-13

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name,
who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

- C. What blessings do we receive with our inheritance in Christ?
- I. Our Inheritance Eternal Life Heaven
- One of the greatest blessings that God has given us is the inheritance or rather the privilege of becoming his inheritance or heritage
- The moment we are saved we become the heritage of God

- 8. Love, joy, peace and righteousness in the Holy Spirit Romans 14:17.

- 9. Victory and freedom from the bondage of sin– Romans 8:11.
- **10.** More than conquerors in all things Romans 8:37.
- 11. An abundance of grace for every good work2 Corinthians 9: 8.

Genesis 12:1-4

¹ Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go forth from your country, And from your relatives And from your father's house, To the land which I will show you;

² And I will make you a great nation, And I will bless you, And make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing;

³ And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

⁴ So Abram went forth as the LORD had spoken to him; and Lot went with him. Now Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran.

D. In Christ, Jews receive an inheritance

Psalm 2:8

8 'Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, And the very ends of the earth as Your possession.

Psalm 16:5-6 The LORD is the portion of my inheritance and my cup; You support my lot. The lines have fallen to me in pleasant places;

Indeed, my heritage is beautiful to me.

D. In Christ, Jews receive an inheritance

Hebrews 9:15

For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

Hebrews 11:8

By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going.

E. In Christ, Gentiles receive an inheritance

By hearing the word of truth, which is the gospel, and believing in Christ

Ephesians 1: 13

¹³ In Him, you also, after <u>listening to the</u> message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,

E. In Christ, Gentiles receive an inheritance

1 Corinthians 15:3-5

- ³ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that <u>Christ died for our sins</u> according to the Scriptures,
- ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,
- ⁵ and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve.

F. Our inheritance in Christ is guaranteed by the Holy Spirit

By the sealing of the Holy Spirit who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we take possession of it

Ephesians 1: 13 – 14

¹³ In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were **sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise**,

who is **given as a pledge of our inheritance**, with a view to the redemption of *God's own* possession, to the praise of His glory.

F. Our inheritance in Christ is guaranteed by the Holy Spirit

2 Corinthians 1:21-22

- Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God,
- who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.

1 Peter 1:3-5

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

4 to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,

who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

1. Our inheritance in Christ is imperishable.

19 "Do not store up for yourselves treasures

Matthew 6:19-21

on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰ "But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; ²¹ for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

1. Our inheritance in Christ is imperishable.

1 Peter 1:22-23

Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart,

for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God.

2. Our inheritance in Christ is undefiled.

Hebrews 7:25-26

Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

For it was fitting for us to have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens;

2. Our inheritance in Christ is undefiled.

Revelation 21:24-27

- ²⁴ The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it.

 25 In the daytime (for there will be no night there) its gates will
- never be closed;
- ²⁶ and they will bring the glory and the honor of the nations into
- and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

⁸ By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was

going.

⁹ By faith he lived as an alien in the land of promise, as in a foreign land, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob,

fellow heirs of the same promise;

10 for he was looking for the city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God.
