

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

### **LESSONS AND APPLICATIONS**

34:8-11 - Here we find an example of superficial repentance. Judah's sin is revealed concerning their failure to release their servants after 7 years. When they hear it they obey but later they change their mind and made their servant return. Similarly today, many will repent in the presence of those who are exposing their wrong, but when their backs are turned they revert back to their sinful ways. This is NOT true repentance.
