Salvation

- * Justification Freedom from sins penalty Romans 8:1-2
- * Sanctification Freedom from sins power Philippians 2:12-13
- * Glorification Freedom from sins presence 2 Timothy 4:7-8

Salvation from...?

- * From what have we been saved?
 - * A wicked world Acts 2:40
 - * Our own sins Ephesians 2:5
 - * We were dead in sins, but made alive through Christ
 - * By God's grace we were saved
 - * Jesus came to save sinners 1 Timothy 1:15

Salvation from...?

- * Our own sin (cont)
 - * The effect of sin on a person is death
 - * Romans 6:23 The wages of sin is death
 - * James 5:19-20 Save a soul from death by turning a sinner away from sin

Salvation from...?

- * Those in sin are subject to God's wrath
 - * Colossians 3:6 The wrath of God
 - * Romans 5:8-10 Save God's wrath by the blood of Christ
 - * 1 Thessalonians 5:9 Salvation is the opposite of God's wrath

- * Eternal Life
 - * 1 Cor 1:18 Perishing is the opposite of being saved
 - * John 3:16. Eternal life is the opposite of perishing, hence eternal life is the same as being saved.

- * Justification
 - * Romans 5:9-10 Saved by the blood of Christ
 - * Romans 3:24-26 Christ's blood justifies us

- * Reconciliation
 - * Romans 5:9-11 The blood of Christ saves us through reconciliation to God
 - * Colossians 1:19-23 We are reconciled through the body of Jesus

- * Forgiveness of sins
 - * Romans 5:9 Jesus blood shed to save us
 - * Matthew 26:28 That shed blood brings forgiveness of sins
 - * Romans 3:25 It is a propitiation for our sins
 - * Ephesians 1:7 We have redemption through Jesus Blood

- * Sanctification
 - * Hebrews 13:12 Jesus sanctified people through His blood
 - * Revelation 1:5-6 Our sins have been washed away
 - * Revelation 7:14 Made white in the blood of the lamb
 - * John 1:6-7 His blood cleanses us from all sin

Salvation and removal of sin

- * One cannon be saved and sin Romans 6:1-2
- * We are freed from sin Romans 6:3-7
- * We cannon seek justification while remaining in sin Galatians 2:17
- * Sin creates a barrier between man and God so we cannot abide with God while in sin 1 John 3:4-6

Permanence of Salvation

- * As long as we remain with God, our salvation is permanent
- * Hebrews 3:6 If we hold our confidence and hope to the end
- * Hebrews 3:14 If we remain steadfast to the end
- * If we do not remain steadfast, our fate is worse 2 Peter 2:20
- * We must take hold of the eternal life offered and not wonder why 1 Timothy 6:9-12
- * Better things await us Hebrews 6:9-12
