- Love is not reckoned as real love unless it is a working love
- No works are right works that do not flow from love to Jesus
- More a token of salvation than "enlightenment" and "tasting"
- It is His promise not our merit that would make it unrighteous were He not to reward His people's work. God is no man's debtor

Things that always accompany salvation

- They had served and would continue to serve --God blesses the field that has already borne good fruit
- Philippians 1:6
- All our strength comes from God
- It is impossible to think of God looking with indifference on those who serve Him
- It is impossible to think of God as not affording them help and encouragement
