- 1 Peter 1:3
- ³ Blessed be the <u>God</u> and <u>Father of our</u>
- Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His

A. The Mercy of God Hebrews 4:16

- ¹⁶ Therefore let <u>us draw near with</u>
- confidence to the throne of grace,
- so that <u>we may receive mercy</u> and find grace to help in time of need.

A. The Mercy of God 1. God's great mercy causes Christians to be born again to a living **hope** through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

<u>God's mercy</u> allows Christians <u>to</u>
<u>find grace</u> in their time of need.

⁵ Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why are you disturbed within me? <u>Hope in</u> <u>God</u>, for I shall again praise Him, <u>The help</u> <u>of my countenance and my God</u>.

- times was written for our instruction, so
- that through perseverance and the

- might have hope.

- 1 Peter 3:5
- ⁵ For in this way in **former times** the **holy**
- women also, who hoped in God, used to
- adorn themselves, being submissive to
- their own husbands;

- B. Attributes of the Living Hope5. Is secured by the resurrection of JesusChrist
- John 11:25-26
- ²⁵ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection
- and the life; he who believes in Me will live
- even if he dies,
- ²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"

- 5. Is secured by the resurrection of Jesus Christ
- John 14:19
- ¹⁹ "After a little while the world will no

longer see Me, but <u>you will see Me</u>; because I live, you will live also.

5. Is secured by the resurrection of Jesus Christ

1 Cor. 15:17-21 ¹⁷ and <u>if Christ has not been raised</u>, <u>your faith is worthless</u>; you are still in your sins.

¹⁹ If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied.

²⁰ But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep.

²¹ For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead.
