### Jesus' life

• Jesus embodied the concept of "grace",

For of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace.

John 1:16 (NASB)

Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given.

John 1:16 (NIV)

## In other words...

<u>Rom 5:20</u> The Law came in so that the offense would increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,

<u>Rom 5:21</u> so that, as sin reigned in death, so also grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 5:20-21 (NASB)

### Jesus teaches

- Jesus is never recorded as using the term "grace"
- He does teach the concept,
  - Matthew 18:21-35
  - Luke 10:30-37
  - Luke 15:1-32 (note also the older son's rebuke)
- Some teaching is confusing
  - Matthew 22:1-14 (invitation vs. clothing)

### Jesus teaches

- Miracles were demonstration of gifts and sometimes connected with faith
  - Mark 2:1-13 ("seeing their faith" may refer to all 4)
  - Mark 9:27-31
  - Mark 8:1-9 (note: they remained with Him)
  - Matthew 10:5-15
